



**PRAISE**: "I will give thanks to you, LORD, with all my heart; I will tell you of all your wonderful deeds - Ps 9:1 *Praise God for who He is and His love, goodness, and recount all the wonderful things he has done.* 

WAITING: "Be still and know that I am God." - Ps 46:10 Before we run ahead with our own agenda we need to take time and pause and reflect that no matter what God is in control. When your mind wanders, use this phrase to refocus.

**CONFESSION:** "If we confess our sins he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness." - 1 John 1:9

Ask God to reveal attitudes or actions that need repentance. Receive God's grace and forgiveness for them.

**MISSION:** "And he said to them, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest" - Luke 10:2

Pray earnestly that God would raise up people in both Walpole and Keene as laborers for the harvest.

**WISDOM:** "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you." - James 1:5

Pray that God would give the leadership of the church wisdom in future decisions, new hires, and directions.

**LOST (OIKOS):** "...and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel..." - Eph 6:19

Pray for your friends, family, and those within your sphere of influence that don't know Jesus. Pray for boldness and opportunity in sharing God's love.

**GENEROSITY:** "But as you excel in everything--in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all earnestness, and in our love for you--see that you excel in this act of grace also (financial generosity)" - 2 Cor 8:7 **Pray that our congregation will grow in generosity and that there will be widespread enthusiasm and participation in giving to church planting efforts.** 

INTERCESSION: "First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgiving be made for all people." - 1 Tim 2:1 Pray for the needs of friends, family, and neighbors

**PERSONAL NEEDS:** "Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need." - Hebrews 4:16

Pray for your own personal needs and burdens.

**LISTENING:** "And after the earthquake a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire, and after the fire a still small voice." - 1 Kings 19:12

Spend time listening for God's voice. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you in this moment through prayer?

**UNITY:** "I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one..." - John 17:21

Pray for the unity of our church so we can be united in love and mission. Pray against anything that will cause division.

**THANKSGIVING:** "Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good. His love endures forever." - Ps 136:1 **Thank God for anything He showed you during this time, thank Him for all His goodness.**
